

WEDSTRIJDREGLEMENT

1 Goal of the competition

1.1 Organizing an international entry level competition in 2-way and 3-way formation skydiving in multiple disciplines.

1.2 Determining the winners of the 2Tunnel Indoor Challenge in Rookie and Advanced class according to the definitions in section 6.

1.3 To motivate, stimulate and develop formation skydiving in general.

1.4 Exchanging knowledge and experiences, strengthening the bonds between skydivers, teams, indoor skydivers, clubs and drop zones.

2 Datum, plaats en tijd

2.1 The 2Tunnel 2-way and 3-wa challenge is an indoor competition that takes place at Indoor Skydive Roosendaal.

2.2 The competition takes place on the announced dates (see ISR website or 2Tunnel Facebook page).

2.3 The registration needs to be completed no less then a week before the competition.

2.4 The prize ceremony takes place after the competition at Bravo24.

3 Organisatie en Wedstrijdleiding

3.1 The organisation of the 2Tunnel event is with the Indoor Skydive Roosendaal staff. On the day of the competition the Indoor Skydive Roosendaal staff is in charge of the competition in collaboration with the Tunnel Visie crew.

4 Algemeen Reglement

4.1 The 2Tunnel Challenge will be hosted along the lines of the current FAI Sporting Code, General Section and the FAI Sporting Code, Section 5 plus the Competition Rules for the 4-way formation skydiving. The 2Tunnel competition is not a official FAI competition, therefore the organisation has the liberty to diverge when necessary.

4.2 Once the draw has been made public participants aren't allowed to practice the draw or similar jumps.

4.3 The competition officials need to monitor the competition rules mentioned at item 4.1 as to prevent foul play.

4.4 All competitors accept the competition rules by registering for the competition.

4.5 All rounds will be judged on location with the use of video footage by the jury.

4.6 The total completed formations, according to the draw, in the first 35 seconds of the round will be judged and given a score for the participating team.

4.7 In rookie FS, rookie MFS and rookie HU the time will start after the first formation is released. In advanced FS, advanced MFS and advanced HU the time will start as soon as 1 participant has left the floor outside of the tunnel with both feet.

4.8 In case the participating team claims to be entitled to a rejump, the competition officials will decide about this. The decision needs to be checked with one of the staff of Indoor Skydive Roosendaal before the decision is final.

4.9 The decision to award a rejump needs to be in line with the determinations at item 4.1.

4.10 Competitors need to wear a hard helmet that covers the ears.

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4.11 Camera's and cameramounts attached to a helmet (in any shape or form) aren't allowed.

5 Deelname en deelnametarieven

5.1 The entry fee needs to be transferred before the competition starts, unless stated otherwise by the organization. The necessary information will be given beforehand.

5.2 The entry fee won't be restituted when a team cancels.

5.3 The entry fee is ϵ 75,- per participant including lunch. The entry fee needs to be transferred before the end of the registration deadline.

5.4 The registration deadline is 1 week before the competition.

5.5 After the registration deadline has passed all teams will receive an update with the latest information.

6 Samenstelling van de teams

6.1 It is possible to register as a team or as an individual.

6.2 It is allowed to include an alternate team member.

6.3 The alternate can be part of other teams.

6.4 In any case a team wants to enlist a non-registered alternate, permission by the competition officials is required.

6.5 Participation, can take place in different categories and disciplines. Formation Skydiving Rookie and Advanced, Mixed Formation Skydiving Rookie and Advanced (Belly – Back), Head Up Rookie and Advanced (Sitfly).

6.6 **Guideline** for FS Rookie/Advanced; An advanced team consists of two participants with more than 200 jumps and/or more than 1 hour of tunnel time.

6.7 Entry in Rookie or Advanced category in the MFS and HU disciplines are determined by the participants themselves.

6.8 The category in which you want to register need to be confirmed during the registration.

6.9 The competition officials need to ensure themselves that involved participant are actually capable of participating in the desired categories. If necessary the officials can move a team to a different class or change wind speeds for safety reasons.

7 Wedstrijdprogramma

7.1 On the day of the competition

7.2 The warm-up round and competition rounds are to be flown on the competition day.

7.3 The competition results are official when at least 50% of the participants have done 3 or more competition rounds.

7.4 Completing 6 competition rounds is the responsibility of the teams.

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8 Volgorde van de sprongen

8.1 The draw will be published on the competition day and all teams will follow this draw during the competition 8.2 The organization will attempt to notify the teams when they need to get ready for their rounds. The teams will however always stay responsible to be informed how late they need to be ready.

9 Prijzen

9.1 Three prizes will be available for each category depending on how many registrations there are and will be given out at the end of the competition during the prize giving ceremony.

10 Jurering

10.1 The initial judging will take place locally by a local representative.

10.2 As soon as the local representative sees an opportunity the scores will be

10.3 Scores will be communicated live during the event.

10.4 In the lines of the initial judging official rankings will be published during the event.

10.5 The official ranking will be published on the 2Tunnel Facebook page.

10.6 Het officiële klassement wordt na afloop gepubliceerd op de 2Tunnel Facebook pagina.

10.7 The competition videos will be available in the team room after the competition (teams need to bring their own USB-stick).

12 Overige zaken

12.1 Anything that isn't discussed in this document will be decided during the event by local representatives and experts.

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
